CHAPTER 86-H. F. No. 600.

An act to repeal Chapter 394, Special Laws for 1887 as amended by Chapter 358, Special Laws for 1891, relating to salaries of county officers in Dakota County, Minnesota. Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Dakota county officials placed on a general salary basis.—That chapter 394, Special Laws for 1887 as amended by chapter 358, Special Laws for 1891 be and the same is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 87-S. F. No. 210.

An act to amend Section 6083, General Statutes of 1913, relating to auctioneers' license.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Auctioneers' licenses to be granted to any person making sales of pure bred or graded live stock.—Section 6083 of the General Statutes of 1913 is hereby amended to read as follows:

6083. The county board or auditor may license any voter in its county as an auctioneer. Such license shall be issued by the auditor and shall authorize the licensee to conduct the business of an auctioneer in the state of Minnesota for the period of one year. It shall be recorded by the auditor in a book kept for that purpose. Before such license is issued the licensee shall pay into the county treasury a fee of ten dollars (\$10.00). Provided, that any person may be licensed as an auctioneer for the purpose of making sales of pure bred or grade live stock only upon the payment of the fee and the giving of the bond as above provided.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 88-S. F. No. 234.

An act to amend Section 6393, General Statutes 1913, relating to investments of savings banks.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Investments of savings banks in farm loan bonds issued by federal land bank in Minnesota district permitted.— That section 6393, General Statutes 1913, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:
