CHAPTER 377-S. F. No. 788.

An act to legalize conveyances of real property heretofore made by a married man or married woman directly to his or her spouse, and the record of such conveyance.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Certain conveyances of real property from one spouse to another legalized.—That all conveyances of real property heretofore made in this state in which a married man or married woman has conveyed real property directly to his or her spouse, shall be and the same are hereby declared to be legal and valid and the records of such conveyances heretofore actually recorded in the office of the register of deeds of the proper county, shall be in all respects valid and legal; such conveyances and the records thereof shall have the same force and effect in all respects as conveyances of title and for the purpose of notice, evidence or otherwise, as may be provided by law in regard to conveyance and their records in other cases. Provided, that the provisions of this act shall not apply to any action or proceeding now pending in any of the courts of this state.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 378-S. F. No. 809.

An act to provide that the positions of director of the state teachers' employment bureau and secretary board of trustees of the teachers' insurance and retirement fund may be held by the same person and that his salary may be paid one-half from the department of education maintenance appropriation and one-half from the teachers' insurance and retirement fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Director and secretary may be held by one person. —That the position of director of the state teachers' employment bureau provided by section 2868, General Statutes 1913, and the position of secretary of the board of trustees of the teachers' insurance and retirement fund provided by section 4, chapter 199, Laws 1915, may be held by one and the same person.

Sec. 2. Payment of salary.—That the salary of the director of the state teachers' employment bureau and the secretary of the board of trustees of the teachers' insurance and retirement fund, when the two positions are held by one and the same person shall be paid one-half from the department of education maintenance appropriation and one-half from the teachers' insurance and retirement fund.

Sec. 3. Inconsistent acts repealed.—All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
