

## CHAPTER 468—H. F. No. 1127.

*An act relating to the salary of county probation officer in counties having a population of 400,000 or more inhabitants.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Salary of probation officer in certain counties.**—That in all counties in this state, now or hereafter having a population of 400,000 or more inhabitants, the county probation officer shall receive an annual salary of two thousand (\$2,000.00) dollars payable in equal semi-monthly installments as the salaries of other county officials are paid.

Sec. 2. **Inconsistent acts repealed.**—All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

## CHAPTER 469—H. F. No. 1143.

*An act authorizing the president of village councils to appoint with the approval of the council hospital boards in certain cases and empowering said councils to prescribe the powers and duties of such board.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Hospital board in villages.**—The president of any village council now or hereafter organized, which village may have established therein a village hospital, may appoint a hospital board consisting of five members. Of the first five members appointed one shall be appointed for a term ending in one year, one for a term ending in two years; one for a term ending in three years; one for a term ending in four years and one for a term ending in five years, and thereafter each member shall be appointed for a term of five years. Any vacancy on the board shall be filled by the president of the village council with the approval of the council for the unexpired portion of the term in which the vacancy occurs.

Sec. 2. **Salary of board members.**—Each member of such board shall receive an annual salary of such sum if any as the village council may prescribe. The member of such board whose term first expires shall be chairman.

Sec. 3. **Powers and duties.**—Such hospital board shall have such powers and duties in connection with the management and operation of such hospital as may be conferred and prescribed by the village council wherein the same is situated.

Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
