RESOLUTION No. 10—H. F. No. 58.

*A joint resolution consenting to the erection of a statue of the late Senator Nelson on the Capitol grounds.*

WHEREAS, Governor J. A. O. Preus, during his term of office appointed a "Knut Nelson Memorial Association," of which Mr. Charles W. Gordon was made chairman, and

WHEREAS, said committee has received contributions and donations from various individuals in the state for the purpose of erecting a suitable memorial statue of the late Senator Nelson, and

WHEREAS, said committee desires to erect this statue on the grounds of the Capitol,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the legislature of the State of Minnesota, the Senate concurring, that the consent of the state of Minnesota be and the same hereby is granted to the erection of the statue of the late Senator Nelson on the approach to the front of the capitol building opposite the present statue of Governor Johnson, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the governor of this state in cooperation with the committee referred to, arrange for the erection of said statue of Senator Nelson on the site referred to, and that at the proper time the governor arrange a suitable ceremony for the unveiling thereof and for memorial services.
