## CHAPTER 161-S. F. No. 719

An act to amend General Stututes 1923, Section 2903, relating to the employnent and payment of teachers in public schools.
Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:
Section 1. Hiring of teachers.-That General Statutes 1923, Section 2903, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:
"2903. School boards shall hire teachers at meetings called for that purpose. No teacher related by blowd or marriage, within the fourih degrec, computed by the cizill lan', to a trustee shall be employed, except by a unanimous vote of the full bxard. The employment shall be by written contract. signed by the teacher. and in common districts, by at least two of the trustees; in special and independent districts, by the chairman and clerk. Such contract shall syecify the time of employment, and the wages per month. Provided, nothing hercin shall be construcd as pricenting a teucher from recosering the value of his or her services from any school district. Eshere such services zuerc herchofore rendered by such teucher pursuant to oral ayriciment awith the efuzerning body of such school district."

## CHAPTER 162-S. F. No. 10\%\%

An act defining overrun and percentage of onerrun in the mannfacture of butter. limiting the percentage of inetrun permissible in such manufacturc. prosiding penaltic's and prescribing ruli's of cividence in proscruting thereunder.
He it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :
Section 1. Definitions.-For the purposes of this att "overrun" is the difference between the weight of any given amount of pure butter fat and the weight of the butter manufactured therefrom, and this difference, ascertained in any case, divided by the given amount of pure butter fat in such case and mutiplied by 100, is the "percentage of overrun," in the manufacture of butter.
