CHAPTER 165-H. F. No. 1393

An act relating to filing fees for the extension of the corporate term of county agricultural societies.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. County agricultural societies may renew corporate existence.—That any corporation heretofore or hereafter organized as a county agricultural society under any law of this state is hereby authorized to extend the term of its corporate life in the manner prescribed by law without the payment of any filing fee or other fee to the State of Minnesota.

CHAPTER 166-H. F. No. 1395

An act to amend Section 738-1 Mason's Minnesota Statutes, 1927, relating to lands for agricultural fair purposes lying within townships and cities of the first and second classes of the State.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Lands owned and used by counties for agricultural fair purposes exempt from zoning ordinances in certain cases.—That Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 738-1, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Whenever lands lying within the corporate limits of townships or cities of the first and second classes of the State are owned by a County and used for agricultural fair purposes, such lands and the buildings now, or hereafter erected thereon shall be exempt from the zoning, building, and other ordinances of such township or city. Provided further that no license or permit need be obtained from nor fee paid to such township or city in connection with the use of such lands."
