CHAPTER 182—H. F. No. 1102

An act to amend Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927, Section 1095, relating to designation of places for posting of legal notices in towns.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Designation of places for posting of legal notices.—That Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927, Section 1095, be amended to read as follows:

"1095. The voters at each annual town meeting shall designate three places in the town as public places at which the legal notice shall be posted, and provide facilities for posting notices at such places—; *provided, however, that in any town in which there is located within its geographical limits a city or village, one or more such notices may be posted in such city or village.*"

CHAPTER 183—H. F. No. 1159

An act to appropriate the sum of \$5,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary from monies collected for licenses by the Game and Fish Department of the State of Minnesota, for the purpose of erecting a dam at the outlet of Mud Lake; Cass County, Minnesota.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for dam at Mud Lake.—There is hereby appropriated from monies collected for licenses by the Game and Fish Department of the State of Minnesota, the sum of \$5,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for the purpose of erecting a dam at the outlet of Mud Lake, Cass County, Minnesota.
