

with such spawning, the proceeds of the sale of such fish to be paid into the state treasury as required of other receipts of the department, *provided, however, that no fish or fish eggs shall be placed in any waters unless such waters are accessible to the public for fishing purposes.*

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 377—S. F. No. 1031

*An act to repeal Section 2719, and Section 2720, of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, relating to the marking of rubber tires or casings.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Law repealed.**—That Section 2719 and Section 2720, of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, be and the same are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 378—S. F. No. 1036

*An act authorizing the possession and use of pet raccoons for the purpose of training dogs.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Pet raccoons may be kept.**—It shall be lawful for any person, with the written permission of the Commissioner of Game and Fish, to keep and have in possession a raccoon and to use the same for the purpose of training dogs for the hunting of raccoons.
