## CHAPTER 85-S. F. No. 816

An act providing for the appointment of a committee to investigate the feasibility of the state participating in the World's Fair to be held at Chicago, and appropriating money for the expenses of such committee.

WHEREAS a World's Fair is to be held at Chicago, Illinois, in 1933; and whereas the State of Minnesota has been solicited to take part therein and to exhibit thereat, NOW THEREFORE, Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

- Section 1. World's Fair committee appointed.—That the Governor is hereby authorized to appoint a committee of five citizens of the state, said members to be representative of the manufacturing, industrial, agricultural and tourist interests, to investigate the feasibility of the state participating in said World's Fair, the nature and extent of its participation, if feasible, and the amount necessary to defray the cost thereof, and to report to the governor and to the legislature at the present session its recommendations in respect thereto.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation.—That there is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the revenue fund of the state treasury, available forthwith, the sum of \$500.00, or so much thereof as may be required therefor, to defray the necessary expenses of the members of said committee in carrying out and performing the duties imposed upon the committee.

## CHAPTER 86-S. F. No. 198

An act making every person who places any foul, offensive or injurious substance or compound, or any gas, fluid or substance injurious to life or property, or any noxious or offensive gas, fluid or substance in, upon, under, against or near to any building, car, vessel or structure, with intent to wrongfully injure, molest or co-erce another or to molest another in the use, management, conduct or control of his business or property, or who aids or abets, or conspires to aid or abet such act, guilty of a gross misdemeanor and providing penalties therefor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Certain acts to be misdemeanor.—Every person who shall willfully place or deposit, or cause to be placed or deposited, or who aids or abets or who conspires to aid or abet in
