

department and no person receiving such pension shall be entitled to other relief from such association. No payments made or to be made by said association to any member on the pension roll shall be subject to judgment, garnishment or execution, or other legal process, and no person entitled to such payment shall have the right to assign the same, nor shall the association have the authority to recognize any assignment or pay over any sum which has been assigned.

Sec. 2. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage."

CHAPTER 125—S. F. No. 1456

An act legalizing certain tax levies heretofore made.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Tax levies validated.**—In all counties in this State where the tax levies for general revenue purposes, levied for the year 1932 and collectible in the year 1933, exceed existing limitations, such levies are hereby approved, legalized and made valid.

CHAPTER 126—H. F. No. 1667

An act appropriating \$35,000.00 to the Board of Control for the purpose of providing hay and feed for livestock in drought stricken areas of this State.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Appropriation for drouth sufferers.**—There is hereby appropriated out of moneys in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$35,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, payable to the State Board of Control, for the purpose of being used by said Board of Control to carry on the activity through the Agricultural Department in caring for and providing feed for livestock in drought stricken areas of this State. That the distribution of said funds by said Board of Control be used and distributed through the agencies and activities now carrying on the work of giving aid to farmers in those counties where there is imminent danger of cattle and livestock suffering on account of provisions to feed them with.

Sec. 2. The action of the Executive Council of this State in appropriating \$25,000 for a similar purpose is hereby in all things ratified and confirmed.

CHAPTER 127—S. F. No. 1454

An act amending Section 21 of Chapter 397, Laws of Minnesota for 1929, relating to the construction, equipping, furnishing, maintaining and operating of a joint city hall and court house building by any county and city of the first class within the limits of such county, and authorizing said city and county to expend joint funds for the improvement and maintenance of meeting halls or quarters in an auditorium owned by such city for organizations the membership whereof is composed of persons who served the United States in the Army, Navy or Marine Corps in the Civil War, Spanish American War, Phillipine Insurrection, Boxer Uprising, Chinese Relief Expedition or the recent World War, and for the auxiliaries to or of said organizations.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **City councils and county board may provide meeting places for military organizations.**—That Section 21 of Chapter 397, Laws of Minnesota for 1929 be amended by adding to it the following:

“If in the opinion of the City Council and County Board, it is inadvisable to provide meeting halls or quarters in the city hall and court house, for organizations the membership whereof is composed of persons who served the United States in the Army, Navy or Marine Corps in the Civil War, Spanish-American War, Phillipine Insurrection, Boxer Uprising, Chinese Relief Expedition, or the recent World War, and for the auxiliaries to or of said organizations, and in the opinion of said bodies such halls or quarters should be provided, the County Board and City Council may provide not to exceed Fifteen Thousand (\$15,000) Dollars, for the improving, out of funds issued for the erection of a new court house and city hall, of such halls or quarters in a municipally owned auditorium building for such organizations and their auxiliaries. In the event that halls or quarters in a municipal auditorium are improved for the use of such organizations and their auxiliaries such halls and quarters shall be under the sole control and management of the same persons or committees as manage the city hall and court house building; and all costs of heating, lighting and operation of such halls or quarters shall be the expense of such persons
