

CHAPTER 76—S. F. No. 168

An act to appropriate money for the payment of the burial expense of Kenneth G. Murphy.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Appropriation for burial expense.**—There is hereby appropriated out of funds in the Soldiers' and Sailors' Burial Fund, the sum of \$75.00 covering the burial expense of Kenneth G. Murphy, Battery D, 151st Field Artillery, such money to be paid to Gill Brothers, Funeral Directors.

CHAPTER 77—S. F. No. 76

An act authorizing Building and Loan Associations incorporated under the laws of the State of Minnesota to convert themselves into Federal Savings and Loan Associations, and thus to acquire the right to sell their preferred stock to the Government of the United States.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Building and Loan Associations may convert themselves into Federal Loan Associations.**—That any Building and Loan Association organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Minnesota is hereby authorized and empowered, by majority vote of its shareholders present either in person or by proxy at any meeting of its shareholders duly called for that purpose, to convert itself into a Federal Savings and Loan Association as provided in that certain Act of the Congress of the United States known as the "Home Owners Loan Act of 1933."

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER 78—S. F. No. 233

An act to amend Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 8585, Subdivision 4, as amended by Chapter 324, of the Laws of 1933.
