

of fifty per cent of the license fee shall be imposed if license is not applied for within the same calendar month that first sale of cigarettes is made." *Provided further, that a license fee due either in January or February, 1935, may be paid prior to April 1, 1935, without a penalty, and provided further, that any penalties heretofore paid, on account of the fee imposed herein, shall be refunded to the parties who made such payment or payments.*

CHAPTER 26—H. F. No. 173

An act to repeal Laws of 1929, Chapter 33, relating to the sale of cattle at public auction, mortgage foreclosure sale or sale by order of any court.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Law repealed.**—That Laws of 1929, Chapter 33 is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 27—H. F. No. 174

An act to repeal Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 5459, relating to the sale of pure bred cattle.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Law repealed.**—That Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 5459 is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 28—H. F. No. 291
