

## CHAPTER 350—H. F. No. 1203

*An act to provide educational opportunities for the children of soldiers, sailors, and marines who were killed in action or died during the World war.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

**Section 1. Appropriation for education of certain children.**

—The sum appropriated under the provisions of this act shall be used for the sole purpose of providing for matriculation fees, board and room rent and books and supplies for the use and benefit of the children not under 16 and not over 22 years of age and who have for two years had their domicile in the state of Minnesota, of those who were killed in action or died from other causes during the World War, from April 6, 1917, to July 2, 1921, while serving in the Army, Navy or Marine Corps of the United States or as a result of such service; which children are attending or may attend any educational or training institution of a secondary or college grade located within the state of Minnesota and approved by the state board of education. Said children shall be admitted to state institutions of secondary or college grade free of tuition.

**Sec. 2. Monies to be paid to educational institutions.—**

The amounts that may be or may become due to any educational or training institution, not in excess of the amount specified in section 3 hereof, shall be payable to such institution from the fund hereby created on vouchers approved by the state soldiers welfare director. Said director shall determine the eligibility of the children who may make application for the benefits provided for in this act; satisfy himself of the attendance of such children at any such institution and of the accuracy of the charge or charges submitted to said director by the authorities of any such institution, on account of the attendance thereat of any such children.

**Sec. 3. Appropriation.—**The sum of \$4,000.00, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1936, and annually thereafter until 1942, for carrying out the provisions of this act: Provided, that not more than \$200.00 shall be paid under said provisions for any one child for any one year.

**Sec. 4. Unexpended balances reappropriated.—**Any unexpended balance remaining at the end of any fiscal year shall be and remain available for expenditure until June 30, 1942, and thereupon all sums in said fund remaining unexpended shall revert to the state treasury.
