

CHAPTER 103—S. F. No. 14.

An act to appropriate money for the University of Minnesota for the construction of the necessary sanitary sewers on the main campus to divert the sewage from the Mississippi river to the new Minneapolis-St. Paul sanitary district sewer interceptors.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for sewers on University campus.—The sum, hereinafter named, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated from any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated for the purposes specified in the following sections of this Act.

Sec. 2. Same.—For the construction of the sanitary sewers, available immediately\$86,000.00, or as much thereof as may be necessary.

Sec. 3. May be reduced when.—The amount provided for in Section 2, of this Act shall be reduced in an amount equal to any amount granted by the Public Works Administration or any other United States Governmental Agency for this purpose.

 CHAPTER 104—S. F. No. 76.

An act to amend Laws of 1935, Chapter 195, Sections 3, 4 and 5, relating to the purchase and installation of a state radio broadcasting station or stations to be used for police purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. State radio broadcasting stations.—That Laws of 1935, Chapter 195, Section 3, be amended so as to read as follows:

“Sec. 3. When the broadcasting station or stations authorized by this act have been established and are ready for operation, the bureau shall notify immediately the board of county commissioners in each county of the state that such radio service has been established; and forthwith the board shall
