RESOLUTION No. 7—H. F. No. 376.

*A joint resolution setting the date of adjournment of the Legislature sine die and rescinding and annulling joint resolution heretofore adopted.*

WHEREAS, it has become apparent that it will be impossible to finish the business of the Legislature within the time fixed by H. F. No. 370 heretofore adopted,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the State of Minnesota, the Senate concurring therein, that said H. F. No. 370 heretofore adopted be and the same is hereby rescinded and annulled and

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the extra session of the Minnesota Legislature, called by proclamation of the Governor, to be held December 2, 1935 do adjourn sine die at 12 o'clock noon on Saturday, January 25, 1936. No bill shall be passed on the last day of the session.
