

CHAPTER 133—S. F. No. 689

An act relating to the salary of the judge of probate and clerk hire in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salary of Judge of Probate in certain counties.—

In all counties of this state, now or hereafter containing not less than 425,000 acres and not more than 427,000 acres and containing not less than 18 nor more than 20 full and fractional townships, the annual salary of the judge of probate shall be \$2400, payable in the manner provided by law.

Sec. 2. Probate clerk hire in certain counties.—In every such county the sum of \$750 per year, and such further sum not exceeding \$450 in any one year, shall be allowed for clerk hire in the office of the judge of probate, to be determined and paid in the manner provided by law.

CHAPTER 134—S. F. No. 690

An act relating to the salary of the judge of probate and clerk hire in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salary of Judge of Probate in certain counties.—

In all counties of this state, now or hereafter containing not less than 400,000 acres and not more than 402,000 acres and containing not less than 18 nor more than 20 full and fractional townships, the annual salary of the judge of probate shall be \$2400, payable in the manner provided by law.

Sec. 2. Probate clerk hire in certain counties.—In every such county the sum of \$750 per year, and such further sum not exceeding \$450 in any one year, shall be allowed for clerk hire in the office of the judge of probate, to be determined and paid in the manner provided by law.
