## SESSION LAWS

## CHAPTER 34-S. F. No. 107

An act to fix the salary of the Judge of Probate and the amount of clerk hire of such judge in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salary of Judge of Probate in certain counties.— In every county in this state having a population of not less than twenty thousand, nor more than twenty-two thousand inhabitants, according to the last Federal census, and an assessed valuation, excluding moneys and credits, of not less than \$7,000,000.00 and not more than \$10,000,000.00 and a total acreage of not less than 550,000 acres nor more than 552,000 acres, the salary of the Judge of Probate shall be \$2500.00 per year, payable in twelve equal monthly installments.

Sec. 2. Salaries of Clerks of Probate in certain counties.— Clerk hire in the office of the Judge of Probate in every such county shall be allowed in such sum as shall be fixed by the Judge of Probate, with the approval of the Board of County Commissioners, in a sum not to exceed \$1500.00 per year.

Sec. 3. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

## CHAPTER 35—S. F. No. 557

An act to amend Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Sections 751-2, 751-3, 751-4, 751-7 relating to changing name of or giving a name to any lake, river, stream or other body of water wholly within the boundaries of this state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law amended.—That Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Sections 751-2, 751-3, 751-4, 751-7, be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows:

"751-2. Naming or changing names of lakes, rivers, etc.— Petition to county board.—That whenever it is desired to change the name of, or give a name to any unnamed lake, river, stream or body of water located within the boundaries of this state, *the State Geographic Board or* any 15 or more legal voters, residing within the
