

ganized territory as any such town would be able to levy if such town had not been dissolved.

Section 3. Money to be expended by county board.—The receipts from any such levies shall be credited to the fund or funds of any such unorganized territory and shall be expended by the county board in conducting, administering and governing the affairs of any such unorganized territory.

Section 4. Levies to be legalized.—Any such levies heretofore made and any such funds which have been established and any expenditures heretofore made in any such county are hereby in all respects ratified, legalized, validated, approved and affirmed.

Section 5. Powers of board.—The county board shall possess the same powers to construct, repair and maintain roads and bridges in any such unorganized territory as would be possessed by the town board if such town had not been dissolved.

Section 6. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval.

CHAPTER 396—H. F. No. 1470

An act to appropriate to the state auditor a sum of money for the republication of the official guide books and history of the Minnesota state capitol.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for publication of official guide book.—There is hereby appropriated to the state auditor from any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$1,500 for a revolving fund, the moneys of such fund to be used for the purpose of republishing the official state capitol guide books and history.

Section 2. To be sold at cost.—Said book shall be offered for sale at a price sufficient to defray the cost of printing, publishing and distribution.
