

CHAPTER 49—H. F. No. 553

An act to amend Laws 1925, Chapter 345, Section 2, relating to terms of district court in Nineteenth Judicial District.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Terms of court in Nineteenth Judicial District.—Laws 1925, Chapter 345, Section 2, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“Sec. 2. In addition thereto general terms of court shall be held in Kanabec county on the fourth Tuesday in January, on the fourth Tuesday in March and the third *Monday* in June, for the trial and determination of both criminal and civil cases, but no grand or petit jury shall be drawn or summoned unless the court shall so direct by a written order made and filed with the clerk of court of the county, at least twenty days before the dates herein fixed for holding said court.”

CHAPTER 50—H. F. No. 552

An act to amend Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 163, relating to terms of court in the Nineteenth Judicial District.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Terms of court in Nineteenth Judicial District.—That Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 163, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

“163. That in addition to the general terms of the district court in Washington county, special terms of said court shall be held in said county on the second and fourth Mondays of each month for the trial of issues of fact by the court, the trial of issues of law, the hearing of motions and applications, and all matters except the trial of issues of fact by a jury. *That during the months of June, July, August, and September such special terms shall be held only on the fourth Monday of each said month.*”
