

Section 2. Salary to be fixed as provided by law.—Except for the minimum amount as herein provided, salary or compensation of the clerk of district court shall be as otherwise provided by law.

Section 3. Application of act.—The provisions of this act shall not apply to any county where salary or compensation of the clerk of the district court has been, or may be, fixed by any other act heretofore or hereafter passed by the 1937 Legislature.

CHAPTER 15—H. F. No. 61

An act to amend subdivision 9 of Section 5 of Chapter 382, Laws of 1937, relating to appropriations to poultry associations to aid in the payment of premiums at exhibitions of poultry.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for aid to poultry associations.—That subdivision 9 of Section 5, Chapter 382, Laws of 1937, be amended so as to read as follows:

“9. For poultry associations, to aid in payment of premiums at exhibitions of poultry by the following societies:

Provided, that the Minnesota State Poultry Association (being a consolidation of the Minnesota State Poultry Association of Hennepin County and the Minnesota Fanciers Association of Ramsey County) shall receive not to exceed \$400.00 subject, however, to all other provisions relating to the distribution of the appropriation herein made. Provided, that no one association or society will receive an amount greater than the annual premiums paid to exhibitors by them and shall not in any case exceed the sum of \$200.00 to any one county. Provided further, that any society or association to be entitled to their distributive share of this appropriation shall file annually with the State Auditor, on or before the first day of April of each year, a sworn statement signed by the president or secretary of such association or society, showing the amount of cash premiums paid during the year to exhibitors, and the amount to be distributed to such society or association from said fund shall be based and determined upon the amount of cash premiums paid out as hereinbefore provided. Provided, further, that except as herein provided, that where there is more than one association in a county the amount allotted to such county, not exceeding \$200.00 aforesaid, shall be distributed to the societies in equal amounts.

Provided, that out of the amounts appropriated by Item 9 hereof \$1,000 shall be expended yearly to aid in the payment of premiums for dressed turkeys in connection with special turkey shows. No association or society shall receive an amount greater than the annual premiums paid to exhibitors by them;

provided, further, that the amount so appropriated by Item 9 for payment of premiums at such special dressed turkey educational exhibits shall be expended under the supervision and control of the Minnesota Poultry Improvement Board."

CHAPTER 16—H. F. No. 62

An act to amend Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 1089, as amended by Laws 1933, Chapter 411, Laws 1935, Chapters 151 and 375, and Laws of 1937, Chapter 249, relating to the compensation of certain town officers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Compensation of town officers in certain cases.**—That Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 1089, as amended by Laws 1933, Chapter 411, Laws 1935, Chapters 151 and 375, and Laws 1937, Chapter 249, be and the same hereby is amended so as to read as follows:

"The following town officers shall be entitled to compensation for each day's service necessarily rendered as follows, viz: Assessors, four dollars, and mileage at the rate of five (5) cents per mile for each mile necessarily traveled by him in going and returning from the county seat of the county to attend any meeting of the assessors of the county which may be legally called by the county auditor, and also for each mile necessarily traveled by him in making his return of assessment to the proper county officer; *provided, however, that the electors at the annual town meeting after reading and disposing of the annual report may fix the compensation of the assessor on an annual basis, but such compensation of the assessor in any town having an assessed valuation of more than \$200,000 and less than \$1,000,000 when so fixed shall not exceed \$240.00 in any one year, and provided further, that in all towns having an assessed valuation including money and credits of less than \$200,000, the maximum compensation for assessor in any year shall not exceed \$200.00; provided further, that in all cases where the compensation of any village assessor is determined by the provisions of this act the compensation of such assessor may be fixed by the governing board of such village, not to exceed \$240.00 in one year; supervisors and clerks, three dollars when the service is rendered within the town, and three dollars when*
