~~CHAPTER 237—H. F. No. 1585~~

~~An act legalizing certain proceedings for the acquisition of title to land under the laws relating to taxation and validating the titles acquired thereby as against certain claimed defects in the posting of the notice of expiration of time for redemption.~~

~~Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:~~

~~Section 1.~~ **Proceedings validated.**—Any proceedings heretofore taken for the acquisition of title to real property by the State of Minnesota under the laws of this State relating to taxation are hereby legalized and the title acquired thereby validated when such proceedings were in all respects properly taken and conducted except that in complying with the requirements for posted notice by the Auditor, as provided by Laws 1935, Chapter 278, Section 8, instead of a single posted notice for all parcels, the Auditor made up separate posted notices, and there being so large a number of such notices that it would have been impractical to affix them to a wall, post, or bulletin board, the Auditor posted the ~~said~~ notices in his office by placing them in loose leaf binders, and by keeping and maintaining the ~~said~~ loose leaf binders on a counter in his office, subject to public inspection, and to which all who desired had access.

~~Sec. 2.~~ ^{Section} ~~Not to affect pending actions.~~—The provisions of this Act shall not apply to any action now pending in any of the Courts of this State.
