## CHAPTER 2—H. F. No. 55

An act relating to primary elections in certain cities of the second class.


Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Candidates to file affidavits.—In all cities of the second class not having a Home Rule Charter, each candidate for nomination at the city primary election shall file his affidavit of candidacy in the manner now provided by law, except that such affidavit may be filed up to and including the 20th day before such primary election.

Sec. 2. Inconsistent acts repealed.—All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

 $\checkmark$  Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

An act to amend Laws 1933, Chapter 161, as amended by Laws 1935, Chapter 312, relating to and appropriating money for the State Compensation Revolving Fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for State Compensation revolving fund.—That Laws 1933, Chapter 161, as amended by Laws 1935, Chapter 312, be amended by adding thereto the following:

There is hereby appropriated from the Trunk Highway Fund of the Department of Highways in the State Treasury not otherwise appropriated the sum of \$74,013.12, to be credited to the State Compensation Revolving Fund, and to be used in connection with the payment of workmen's compensation claims of employes of the Department of Highways of the State of Minnesota which, with \$75,986.88 already appropriated, totals \$150,000.00; the latter sum to constitute the State Compensation Revolving Fund and to be used and maintained as herein provided.
