

said repeal takes effect, holds an office under any of the laws repealed, shall continue to hold it according to the tenure thereof, unless it is abolished or unless a different provision relative thereto is made by this act. The provisions of this act, so far as they are the same as those of existing statutes, shall be construed as continuations thereof, and not as new enactments; and references to statutes not repealed to provisions of law which are re-enacted herein shall be construed as applying to such provisions as so incorporated in this act. If in any statute hereby repealed, a limit of time be prescribed for acquiring a right, barring a remedy, or any other purpose, which period has begun to run, and the same or as similar limitation is herein prescribed, the time of limitation shall continue to run with the same effect as though the whole period had elapsed under the operation of this act.

Sec. 3. Effective August 1, 1939.—This act shall take effect and be in force from and after August 1, 1939.

CHAPTER 346—H. F. No. 1618

An act to appropriate money for the installation of electric roll call system in the House of Representatives.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Appropriation for electric roll call system for House of Representatives.—There is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$26,205.45 to be paid to the American Signal Corporation in full payment of balance due said American Signal Corporation for installation of the electric roll call system in the House of Representatives, payment to be made to said American Signal Corporation upon filing with the secretary of state by said corporation a written guarantee approved by the attorney general guaranteeing said electric roll call system against defects of workmanship and material for a period of five years from January 1, 1939.
