

pair, alteration, or removal without a permit therefor; to provide for inspection and approval of any such construction, repair, alteration, or removal; to charge a fee therefor; and to provide that any violation of such regulations shall constitute a misdemeanor punishable according to law.

Sec. 3. Permits to be issued by town board.—The authority to issue permits, to provide inspection of construction, repair, alteration, and removal of any building and of structures dangerous to persons or property and the enforcement of any regulations adopted under the authority conferred in Section 1, shall be vested in the several Town Boards in any such county.

Sec. 4. Town boards must consent.—Before such regulations shall become operative in any town in any such county, the Town Board shall first consent thereto.

CHAPTER 80—S. F. No. 804

An act to authorize the Board of County Commissioners to levy taxes in excess of present limitations for revenue purposes in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Tax levy for general purposes in certain counties.—In all counties of this state containing not less than 24 nor more than 28 full or fractional congressional townships, with a population of not less than 14,000 nor more than 16,000 inhabitants according to the last Federal census and having an assessed valuation, exclusive of money and credits, of not less than \$4,500,000 nor more than \$7,000,000 the board of county commissioners may levy for general revenue purposes, not in excess of \$55,000, that may be necessary to defray expenses payable from the county revenue fund.

CHAPTER 81—S. F. No. 802

An act to authorize certain counties to issue funding bonds for the purpose of paying outstanding road and bridge warrants.
