## CHAPTER 414—S. F. No. 1046

An act fixing the salaries and clerk hire of judges of the probate court in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salaries of judge of probate in certain counties.—In each county of this state now or hereafter having a population of not less than 16,000 nor more than 20,000 inhabitants, and an assessed valuation exclusive of moneys and credits of not less than \$10,000,000 nor more than \$15,000,000, and full and fractional congressional townships of not less than 22 nor more than 30, the salaries of the judge of probate court shall be \$2,200 per annum and he shall be allowed the sum of \$1200 per annum as clerk hire. Said salary and clerk hire shall be paid in the same manner as are salaries of other county officers and employees and shall be in full compensation for all services performed for the county as judge of probate including services performed while acting in capacity as judge of the juvenile court.

## CHAPTER 415—S. F. No. 1224

An act relating to intoxicating liquor; amending Mason's Supplement 1940, Section 3200-28.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law amended.—Mason's Supplement 1940, Section 3200-28, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"3200-28. Regulation of sales—prohibited times, places and persons—orderly conduct—gambling devices—prostitutes—employment of minors—pool and billiard tables.—No sale of intoxicating liquor shall be made on Sunday nor before three o'clock P. M. on any Memorial day nor before eight o'clock P. M. on any Election day in the district in which such election shall be held. No "On sale" shall be made before eight o'clock A. M., or after 12 o'clock midnight on any day. Provided, however, in cities of the first class only, 'On sale' may be permitted until two hours after 12 o'clock midnight on Saturday and until one hour after 12 o'clock midnight on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and
