CHAPTER 538—S. F. No. 1423

An act requesting and directing payment to be made out of the trunk highway fund, or funds accredited thereto from highway patrol fines or other sources, to compensate and reimburse certain persons, firms and corporations for property damage by the location, construction, reconstruction, improvement and maintenance of the trunk highway system, including reimbursement for services rendered and expenses incurred in highway condemnation proceedings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Commissioner of Highways to compensate certain persons for damages.—The Commissioner of Highways is requested and directed, upon receiving receipt and discharge in full from each of the persons, firms and corporations hereinafter named for property damaged in the location, construction, reconstruction, improvement, maintenance and supervision of the trunk highway system, including reimbursement for services rendered and expenses incurred in highway condemnation proceedings, and to pay out of the trunk highway fund, or funds accredited thereto from highway patrol fines or other sources, to each of the persons, firms, or corporations hereinafter named the sums herein set opposite the respective names of each of said persons, firms, or corporations respectively as follows, to-wit:
