

Commencing at a point on the north line of said section 13, 60 rods west of the northeast corner of said section; thence west along said north section line, 20 rods; thence south, 32 rods; thence east, 20 rods; thence north 32 rods to place of beginning.

CHAPTER 385—S. F. No. 1093.

An act relating to the salary and clerk hire in the office of the county treasurer in certain counties.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Salary of County Treasurer in certain Counties.—In all counties of this state having a population of not less than 25,000 nor more than 26,000, according to the Federal census of 1940, and having an area of not less nor more than 24 full or fractional townships, the Board of County Commissioners shall fix the salary of the county treasurer at not less than \$2,500 and not more than \$3,000 per annum.

Sec. 2. Clerk hire.—In all such counties there shall be allowed for clerk hire in the office of the county treasurer the sum of \$200 per year in addition to the amount now provided by law.

CHAPTER 386—S. F. No. 1100.

An act permitting certain counties to pay all or part of the rent for farm security administration offices located therein and legalizing payments therefor hertofore made.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Certain counties may pay rent for farm security administration offices.—In any county in this state now or here-
