CHAPTER 427—S. F. No. 1232.

An act fixing the salaries of county attorneys in certain counties; and amending Laws 1927, Chapter 121, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law amended.—Laws 1927, Chapter 121, Section 1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Salary of county attorney in certain counties.—In each county of this state now or hereafter having an area of more than 2,500 square miles and a population of more than 23,000 inhabitants, according to the last preceding federal or state census, and an assessed valuation of more than \$18,000,000 and less than \$50,000,000 the county attorney shall receive an annual salary of \$3,600 to be paid in equal monthly installments out of the county treasury upon the warrant of the county auditor, in the same manner as other county officers are paid.

CHAPTER 428-H. F. No. 547.

An act relating to the suspension or discharge of certain county employes in counties having, or which may hereafter have, a population of 500,000 or more; and repealing Laws 1941, Chapter 385.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law repealed.—Laws of 1941, Chapter 385, is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 429-H. F. No. 698.

An act providing for an additional "on-sale" liquor license for hotels in certain cities of the fourth class.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Additional on sale liquor license may be granted in certain cities of fourth class.—In any city of the fourth class
