CHAPTER 44-H. F. No. 373

(Amending Section 465.51 Minnesota Statutes 1941.)

An act relating to decoration of certain graves on Memorial Day; amending Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 1933-1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law amended.—Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 1933-1, is amended to read as follows:

1933-1. Decoration of soldiers' graves on Memorial Day by cities, villages and towns; duty of clerks or recorders.—It shall be the duty of the clerks or recorders of all cities and villages, and the town clerks of all towns, within the State of Minnesota, to ascertain, as far as it shall be practicable so to do, if within their respective city, village or town, there are any graves of members of the armed forces of the United States, including nurses and other women who have been members of the various auxiliary forces which are a part of or which are associated with or connected with the armed forces of the United States, which probably will not be decorated at the next Memorial Day, and if any such grave or graves shall be found, it shall be the duty of such city or village clerk or recorder and of such town clerk, to cause any and all such graves within their respective town, city or village, to be decorated annually, upon Memorial Day by placing thereat an American flag.

CHAPTER 45-H. F. No. 247

An act relating to wild animals, authorizing the sale of raccoon and rabbits.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Sale of certain wild animals.—Raccoon, varying hare or snow shoe rabbit and cottontail rabbits lawfully taken, killed and possessed, may be bought and sold at any time; provided that the carcasses of such animals shall not be shipped or transported outside of the state of Minnesota.
