CHAPTER 487—S. F. No. 1137.

An act relating to the powers of the commissioner of highways and governmental subdivisions, authorizing the leasing and renting of equipment and machinery used in the construction and maintenance of highways and streets during the war emergency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Commissioner of highways may rent equipment.—The Commissioner of Highways, is authorized to enter into agreements with any governmental subdivision of the state for the lease or rental of machinery and equipment used in the construction and maintenance of streets and highways. Any governmental subdivision is authorized to enter into agreements with any other governmental subdivision or the Commissioner of Highways for the rental or lease of machinery or equipment used in the construction and maintenance of streets and highways. All agreements made hereunder shall be upon such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon by the parties.

Sec. 2. Emergency act—limitations.—This act is an emergency measure and shall be effective until sixty days after cessation of hostilities in the present war as declared by proper Federal authority and shall then expire, or until July 1, 1945, whichever may first occur.
