CHAPTER 93—H. F. No. 63

An act authorizing the appointment of a deputy treasurer in villages.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Deputy Treasurer in villages.—The treasurer of any village may appoint a deputy treasurer who shall serve as treasurer during the treasurer's disability or absence from the village. The deputy treasurer shall receive such compensation and shall furnish such bond as the council determines. The premium on his bond may be paid from the general fund of the village.

CHAPTER 94—H. F. No. 302

(AMENDING SECTION 375.33 MINNESOTA STATUTES 1941.)

An act relating to county libraries; amending Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 673, Subdivision 3.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Law amended.—Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 673, Subdivision 3, is amended to read as follows:

Subdivision 3. Contract with present library board.—If there is a free public library in the county, the board of county commissioners *may* contract with the board of directors of such library, upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon between such boards, for the use of such library by all residents
