

## CHAPTER 96—H. F. No. 466.

*An act relating to the salaries of county treasurers in certain counties.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

**Section 1. Salaries of County Treasurer in certain counties.**

—In all counties in this state having a population of not less than 22,000 nor more than 24,000 inhabitants, according to the 1940 federal census, and having not less than 28 nor more than 30 full and fractional congressional townships, the Board of County Commissioners is authorized to fix the annual salary of the County Treasurer in an amount of not less than \$2,500.00 nor more than \$3,000.00.

## CHAPTER 97—S. F. No. 286

*An act relating to the salaries and compensation of county officers and their expenses and clerk hire in all counties in this state now or hereafter having not less than 44 nor more than 45 congressional townships, whole or fractional, and now or hereafter having an assessed valuation of not less than \$8,000,000 nor more than \$14,000,000, exclusive of money and credits; amending Laws 1937, Chapter 491, as amended by Laws 1941, Chapter 337.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

**Section 1. Law amended—salary of County Auditor in certain counties.**—Laws 1937, Chapter 491, Section 2, as amended by Laws 1941, Chapter 337, Section 1, is amended to read as follows:

County auditor, \$2,820 per year and fees as now prescribed by law. There also shall be allowed \$6,000 per year for auditor's clerk hire.

**Sec. 2. Salary of County Treasurer in certain counties.**—Laws 1937, Chapter 491, Section 3, is amended to read as follows:

County Treasurer, \$3,120 per year and fees as now prescribed by law. There also shall be allowed \$3,100 per year for county treasurer's clerk hire.

**Sec. 3. Salary of Register of Deeds in certain counties.**—Laws 1937, Chapter 491, Section 4, is amended to read as follows:
