

CHAPTER 254—S. F. No. 940

An act relating to tax levy for revenue purposes in certain counties, amending Laws 1943, Chapter 138, Section 1, and repealing Laws 1943, Chapter 138, Sec. 2.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1943, Chapter 138, Section 1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. **Levy in excess of legal limitations.** In any county in this state now or hereafter having a taxable valuation of real and personal property, exclusive of money and credits, as reported in the abstract of tax lists for the preceding year, in excess of \$11,000,000 and less than \$13,000,000, and containing more than 20,000 and less than 30,000 inhabitants, and containing less than 23 full and fractional congressional townships, and containing a land area of over 700 square miles, the board of county commissioners may levy for general revenue purposes in excess of the legal limitations on such counties not more than one mill.

Sec. 2. **Repeal.** Laws 1943, Chapter 138, Sec. 2, is hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 255—H. F. No. 382

An act to provide for the incorporation and regulation of voluntary nonprofit medical service plan corporations and to prescribe penalties for the violation of the provisions of this act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Purpose.** It is the purpose and intent of this act, and the policy of the Legislature, to make possible a wider and more timely availability of medical care, thereby advancing the public health and the science and art of medicine in this State.

Sec. 2. **Incorporation and organization.** Nonprofit medical service plan corporations hereinafter incorporated may be organized under and in accordance with the provisions of this
