

CHAPTER 437—H. F. No. 907

An act relating to the bond of county auditors, and amending Minnesota Statutes 1941, Section 384.02.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1941, Section 384.02, is amended to read as follows:

384.02. **Bond.** Each county auditor, before entering upon the duties of his office, shall give a bond to the state, to be approved by the county board, in such penal sum, not less than \$5,000, nor more than \$20,000, as such board requires, conditioned for the faithful discharge of the duties of his office, upon which shall be endorsed his oath of office. The bond so endorsed shall be filed and recorded in the office of the register of deeds.

CHAPTER 438—H. F. No. 950

An act relating to real estate taxes against lands owned by persons in military service or their dependents; amending Laws 1943, Chapter 641.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Benefits inure to mortgagee or purchaser.** Laws 1943, Chapter 641, is amended by adding a new section as follows:

If any real estate is subject to a mortgage at the time of acquisition by a person in military service or is mortgaged by him while in military service to secure a bona fide loan, the benefits of this act shall inure to the mortgagee and to the purchaser at any sale on foreclosure of the mortgage.

An act relating to industrial loan and thrift companies, amending Minnesota Statutes 1941, Section 53.04.
