

## CHAPTER 583—S. F. No. 1337

*An act relating to wild animals and the season for trout, amending Laws 1945, Chapter 248, Section 101.41, Subdivision 2.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1945, Chapter 248, Section 101.41, Subdivision 2, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Subdivision 2. Except as otherwise provided, the following fish may be taken only by angling with a single line, transported and possessed, subject to all other provisions of Chapters 97 to 102, between the dates set opposite such species, and the number which may be taken each day or which may be possessed at any one time, subject to the aggregate limits imposed by subdivision 3, shall be as prescribed in the following table:
