

CHAPTER 323—S. F. No. 1038

An act authorizing the commissioner of conservation to issue leases and licenses on trust fund and other state lands for the storing thereon of ore, waste materials from mines, rock and tailings from ore milling plants, and amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 92.50, Subdivision 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 92.50, Subdivision 1, is hereby amended to read as follows:

92.50. Unsold lands subject to sale may be leased. Subdivision 1. The commissioner of conservation may, at public or private vendue and at such prices and under such terms and conditions as he may prescribe, lease any unsold school, university, internal improvement, swamp, or other lands subject to sale by him, for the purpose of taking and removing sand, gravel, clay, rock, marl, peat, and black dirt therefrom, for storing thereon ore, waste materials from mines, or rock and tailings from ore milling plants, and for garden sites, and for other temporary uses that shall not result in any permanent injury to the land. No such lease shall be made for a term to exceed ten years, except in the case of leases of lands for storage sites for ore, waste materials from mines or rock and tailings from ore milling plants, which may be made for a term not exceeding 25 years. All such leases shall be made subject to sale and leasing of the land for mineral purposes under legal provisions and contain a provision for their cancellation at any time by the *commissioner* upon three months' written notice, *provided that a longer notice period, not exceeding three years, may be provided in leases for storing ore, waste materials from mines or rock or tailings from ore milling plants.* All money received from leases under this section shall be credited to the fund to which the land belongs.
