

CHAPTER 336—H. F. No. 1253  
[Coded as Sections 94.521, 94.522]

*An act relating to the distribution and appropriation of moneys received from the federal government as proceeds from the leasing of lands under the Taylor Grazing Act of 1934 and the Flood Control Act of 1938, and amendments thereof.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[94.521] Section 1. **Distribution of moneys received from federal government.** All sums of money heretofore or which may hereafter be received from the United States government on account of the act of Congress approved June 28, 1934 (48 Statutes 1273), amended by act approved June 26, 1936 (49 Statutes 1978), and the act approved June 28, 1938 (52 Statutes 1221), or any amendments thereof heretofore or hereafter enacted shall be expended as follows:

One-half for public schools and the remainder for public roads in the counties in which the land producing such moneys is situated.

[94.522] Sec. 2. **Transmission of warrants to county treasurers; use of proceeds.** It shall be the duty of the state auditor to transmit warrants on the state treasury to the county treasurer of the respective counties for the sums that may be due in accordance with this act, which sums are hereby appropriated out of the state treasury from the amounts received from the United States government pursuant to the aforesaid acts of Congress, and such moneys shall be used by the counties receiving the same for the purposes and in the proportions herein provided.
