

## CHAPTER 106—S. F. No. 421

*An act authorizing the commissioner of conservation to sell certain swamp lands.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Sale of certain lands authorized.** The commissioner of conservation is hereby authorized to sell the West Half of the Southeast Quarter ( $W\frac{1}{2}SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Three (3), and Lot One (1) of Section Ten (10), all in Township One Hundred Forty-seven (147), Range Twenty-six (26) in the same manner as provided by law for the sale of other state swamp lands, notwithstanding the fact that such lands may lie within a state forest area or border the waters of a meandered or an unmeandered lake.

## CHAPTER 107—S. F. No. 471

*An act authorizing the commissioner of administration to sell and the Governor to convey certain lands owned by the State of Minnesota situate in Stearns County.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **Sale of certain lands authorized.** The commissioner of administration is authorized to sell and the governor to convey to the highest bidder the following described real property situate in Stearns County, Minnesota:

“All that part of Lots numbered Three (3) and Four (4), of Section numbered Thirty-five (35), in Township numbered One Hundred Twenty-seven (127), of Range numbered Thirty-four (34), lying and being West and Westerly of the center line of the public highway as now laid out and used across said premises and which said highway runs in a North and South direction and is known as the Brick Yard Road, containing 36.50 acres, more or less.”

The commissioner may in his discretion divide said real property into parcels and sell each parcel to the highest bidder.
