

## CHAPTER 231—H. F. No. 644

*An act relating to zoning and zoning regulation in certain towns, and to amend Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 366.15.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 366.15, is hereby amended so as to read as follows :

366.15. May amend districts or zones. The board of supervisors of any such town where a *majority* of the legal voters voting thereon have voted "Yes" at such election may, from time to time, amend the number, shape, boundary, or area of any district or zone, or any regulation of area within such zone, or any provision of the zoning resolution. Before finally adopting any such amendment the board of supervisors shall hold a public hearing thereon, after giving at least 30 days' notice of the time and place of the hearing, which notice shall be given by at least one publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the county in which such town is located; provided, that no such change shall be made in the boundary line of zones or districts unless at least 50 per cent of the owners of the lands proposed to be changed shall file a petition for such change.

## CHAPTER 232—H. F. No. 646

[Coded as Section 366.021]

*An act relating to the naming of roads and streets in townships situated in counties containing a city of the first class and authorizing the board of supervisors to name roads and streets therein.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

[366.021] Section 1. **Additional powers and duties.** The board of supervisors of any township situated in a county containing a city of the first class shall have authority by ordinance, resolution or by law to name and change the names of streets, avenues, roads, highways, alleys and other public places in said township; and to declare and impose penalties and punishments for violation thereof.
