Sec. 4. Monthly payment into general revenue fund. All such fees shall be collected by the clerk of probate court and shall be paid into the general revenue fund of the county monthly, and a statement thereof made to the county board each month at its first meeting.

Sec. 5. Effective date. This act shall take effect from and after July 1, 1947.

CHAPTER 252—H. F. No. 817

An act relating to veterans service officers in certain counties having an area of more than 5,000 square miles; amending Laws 1945, Chapter 483.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1945, Chapter 483, Section 1, is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. Veterans service officers in St. Louis County. The county board of any county having an area of more than 5,000 square miles and containing five or more cities or villages with a population of more than 5,000 and the governing body of any city or village or combination of cities and villages therein having a population of more than 5,000 may agree upon the appointment of assistant veterans service officers in such municipalities, who shall be assistant veterans service officers of such county within the meaning of Laws 1945, Chapter 96, and may make a written agreement fixing the percentage of the total compensation, costs of travel, and other expenses to be paid by such county and such city or village or combination of cities and villages.

Sec. 2. Laws 1945, Chapter 483, Section 2, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2. Veterans service officers in certain municipalities. The governing body of any city or village or combination of cities and villages having a population of more than 5,000 in such county may appoint and fix the term and compensation,

and manner and time of payment thereof, of a municipal veterans service officer who shall be subject to the direction and control of the veterans service officer, and who shall have the qualifications of, and all the powers of, and be subject to all of the restrictions and shall discharge all the duties imposed upon, assistant veterans service officers, as prescribed by Laws 1945, Chapter 96. Where such municipal veterans service officer is appointed, and there is any overlapping of his duties with those of the county service officer, the county board of such county and the council of such city or village *or combination of cities and villages* may make a written agreement fixing the percentage of the total compensation, costs of travel, and other expenses to be paid by such county and such city or village *or combination of cities and villages*.

Sec. 3. Laws 1945, Chapter 483, Section 3, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 3. **Persons entitled to service.** Any resident of such county shall be entitled to the aid and services of any veterans service officer, assistant veterans service officer, or municipal veterans service officer within such county.

CHAPTER 253—H. F. No. 822

An act relating to the licensing of electricians, providing for temporary licenses in certain cases; amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 326.01, Subdivision 4, and Sections 326.24, 326.25, 326.26, 326.27, 326.31 and 326.32.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 326.01, Subdivision 4, is amended to read as follows:

326.01. **Definitions.** Subd. 4. **Limited Electrician.** The term "*limited electrician*" means a person having the necessary qualifications, training, and experience in wiring for, installing, or repairing special classes of electrical apparatus or equipment *or for special classes of electrical wiring installations*; or making minor alterations, extensions, and repairs
