

CHAPTER 491—S. F. No. 439

[Coded as Section 253.015]

An act relating to state hospitals for the insane; repealing Minnesota Statutes 1945, Sections 253.01, 253.02, 253.06, 253.07, 253.08, and 253.09.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[253.015] **Section 1. Location; superintendents.** The state hospitals located at Anoka, Fergus Falls, Hastings, Moose Lake, Rochester, St. Peter, and Willmar shall constitute the state hospitals for insane, and shall be maintained under the general management of the director of public institutions. The director of public institutions shall determine to what state hospital for insane patients shall be committed from each county and notify the probate judge thereof, and of changes made from time to time. The chief executive officer of each hospital for the insane shall be known as the superintendent.

Sec. 2. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Sections 253.01, 253.02, 253.06, 253.07, 253.08, and 253.09 are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER 492—S. F. No. 480

An act relating to the powers and duties of school boards; and amending Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 125.06, Subdivision 11.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1945, Section 125.06, Subdivision 11, is amended to read as follows:

125.06. Powers and duties of school boards. It may provide for the admission to the schools of the district, of non-resident pupils, and those above school age, and fix the rates of tuition for such pupils. In case a person owns land and pays the taxes thereon, in a common or an independent school district other than the one in which he resides, then such person or his tenant shall be admitted to all the benefits of said school the same as residents therein, upon conforming to such reasonable terms for tuition and transportation as the board of education of such school district may have
