

CHAPTER 50—S. F. No. 287

An act to authorize the governing body of certain villages located within ten miles of any sanitary district to operate a sewage system as part of the waterworks plant and system as a single combined utility and for the financing and payment of improvements thereto and extensions thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Certain villages may combine sewage and water plant; water, light, power and building commission may operate and control; financing of improvement. The governing body of any village located within ten miles of a sanitary district organized under Minnesota Statutes 1945, Chapter 445, and having a population in excess of 3,000, may by ordinance duly adopted determine that the sewage system of the village shall thereafter be operated as part of the waterworks plant and system as a single combined utility for the purpose of furnishing water and sewage and waste disposal services and thereafter said sewage system shall be part of the waterworks plant and system for all purposes.

In event such village has a water, light, power and building commission which has been granted authority over the waterworks plant, said commission shall exercise similar control over the combined utility. Any improvements thereto or extensions thereof may be financed by the issuance of obligations payable from the combined revenues and the proceeds derived from the sale of such obligations may be used to pay for any improvements or extensions to such combined utility.

It is hereby expressly found that this act is necessary to protect the public health by permitting such village to finance the construction of sewage improvements or extensions.
