Cancelation of registration. The board after 153.07.hearing may by majority vote revoke any certificate issued by it and cancel the registration of any chiropodist who has been convicted of violation of the provisions of section 153.08. The board may after hearing by majority vote revoke the certificate and cancel the registration of any person when the court records of any state or territory within the United States, or the federal court records, or the record of any court of jurisdiction in any foreign country, show that such person has been found guilty of a criminal offense. The board may after hearing by majority vote revoke the certificate and cancel the registration of any person whose registration was granted upon mistake of material fact. The board may subsequently, but not earlier than one year thereafter, by unanimous vote. reissue any certificate and register anew any chiropodist whose certificate was revoked and whose registration was canceled by the board.
