

## CHAPTER 531—S. F. No. 1057

[Coded as Section 447.045, Subd. 6.]

*An act relating to the authorization of certain villages to appropriate funds from municipal liquor store earnings to aid in acquisition, construction, improvement, maintenance and operation of a community hospital; amending Laws 1947, Chapter 321, Section 1, and repealing Laws 1947, Chapter 321, Section 2.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[447.045] Section 1. **Nonprofit hospital supported by municipal liquor store profits.** Laws 1947, Chapter 321, Section 1, is amended to read:

Subd. 6. If the voters of any village operating an on-sale, or an off-sale, or an on-sale and off-sale municipal liquor store at a general or special election vote in favor of contributing from the village liquor dispensary fund toward the *acquisition, construction, improvement, maintenance, and operation* of a community hospital, the council may appropriate *such sums of money as said council may from time to time determine* out of the net profits or proceeds of the municipal liquor store to any incorporated non-profit hospital association in the village, governed by a board of directors elected by donors of \$50 or more, who shall each have one vote; and the hospital shall be open to all residents of the community on equal terms.

Sec. 2. Laws 1947, Chapter 321, Section 2, is hereby repealed.
