CHAPTER 361—S. F. No. 768 [Not Coded]

An act authorizing certain counties to issue bonds for improvement of poor farm buildings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. St. Louis County Poor Farm authorized to improve. Any county having an area of not less than 90 or more than 101 full and fractional congressional townships and a taxable valuation of less than \$5,000,000, and which owns a county poor farm with buildings thereon, and operates under the county poor system, is authorized to issue bonds for the reconstruction, alteration, repair, and improvement of necessary buildings on such poor farm, in the sum of not exceeding \$50,000, to be payable within a period of not to exceed five years from the date of issuance.
