Yellow Medicine County: On the first Monday in April and the third Monday in September.

CHAPTER 4—S. F. No. 17

An act authorizing the Governor and the State Auditor to sell and convey to the Village of Bayport, a municipal corporation, certain land in the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of section three (3), township twenty-nine (29) north, range twenty (20) west, Washington county, Minnesota, for cemetery purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. State land; transfer to Bayport. The Governor is hereby authorized and directed to convey to the Village of Bayport, a municipal corporation, by a proper deed, attested by the State Auditor, upon the payment by said Village of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.00) as consideration therefor, the following described real estate owned by the State, situated in Washington County, Minnesota, to-wit: All that part of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 3, Township 29 North, Range 20 West, described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the south line thereof, said point being 103.95 feet west of the southeast corner thereof, and running thence north on a line parallel to and 103.95 feet west of the east line thereof 340 feet; thence west on a line parallel to the south line thereof 125 feet; thence south on a line parallel to the east line thereof 340 feet to the south line thereof; thence east along said south line 125 feet to the point of beginning; containing 0.98 acre, more or less; the same to be used by said Village for cemetery purposes as an addition to its municipally owned cemetery.
