ties. The bailiff shall receive the salary fixed by the Board of County Commissioners, which sum shall include all expenses incurred by him in the performance of his duties within the county.

An act relating to county employees and their compensation in counties having a population of more than 300,000 and less than 450,000 inhabitants; amending Laws 1943, Chapter 2. Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Laws 1943, Chapter 2, Section 1, is amended to read:

Section 1. **Definition.** When used in this act the following words and phrases have the meaning ascribed to them in this section:

- (1) County government means all officers and agencies of the county.
- (2) County means any county having more than 300,-000 and less than 450,000 inhabitants.
