Any funds in the state treasury to the credit of the present board of barber examiners shall be transferred to, and made available for use by, the board established under the provisions of this chapter.

CHAPTER 84—H. F. No. 461 [Coded as Section 614.575]

An act making it a crime to simulate deafness and to sell. or distribute alphabet cards used by the deaf, while peddling or begging.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

[614.575] Section 1. Deafness, simulation a misdemeanor. Any person who, while peddling or begging, simulates deafness and sells or distributes alphabet cards used by the deaf, is guilty of a misdemeanor.
