

\$100 per month to each member of the association who shall have reached the age of 55 years and shall have served 20 years or more as a member of the paid municipal fire department in such city. The monthly payments of \$100 may be increased by adding thereto an amount not exceeding \$5.00 per month for each year of active duty over 20 years of service before retiring; provided, that no such pension or payment shall exceed the sum of \$125 per month. No such pension shall be paid to any person while he remains a member of the fire department.

CHAPTER 145—S. F. No. 869

An act relating to tax levies for sewage disposal plants in certain cities of the fourth class, having a population in excess of 5,000 and assessed valuation of real and personal property in excess of \$4,000,000 and which valuation consists of 50 per cent iron ore; amending Laws 1947, Chapter 477, Section 1.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Section 1. Laws 1947, Chapter 477, Section 1, is amended to read :

Section 1. **Sewage disposal fund, tax levy.** The governing body of any city of the fourth class, however organized, having a population in excess of 5,000 and an assessed valuation of real and personal property in excess of \$4,000,000, and which valuation consists of 50 per cent iron ore, may establish a sewage disposal fund, from which moneys may be expended only for the purpose of acquiring the necessary site for, and of constructing, enlarging, or improving a sewage disposal plant. It may levy for said fund an annual tax not exceeding ten mills, for not to exceed *seven* consecutive years, which levy may be made in excess of any charter millage limitations, but not in excess of the limitations of Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 275.11.
