

## CHAPTER 154—H. F. No. 565

*An act relating to salaries and expenses of members of a county work farm board and of a sanatorium commission in certain counties having a certain area.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. **County work farm board, sanatorium commission; salaries, expenses.** In each county of this state now or hereafter having an area of over 5000 square miles, the members of the county work farm board and the members of the county sanatorium commission shall receive for attending meetings of said board and commission, \$15 per day, but not to exceed \$300 in any one year, and each shall be repaid his necessary expenses for such attendance, a certified statement of which shall be filed with and approved by said board or commission.

CHAPTER 155—H. F. No. 582

*An act relating to wild animals and the definition of minnows; amending Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 97.40, Subdivision 12.*

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 1949, Section 97.40, Subdivision 12, is hereby amended to read:

97.40 Subd. 12. "Minnows" includes chubs, shiners, dace, stonerollers, mudminnows, blunt-nose, fathead, and other small fish commonly used for bait which have only one dorsal fin, and suckers and redhorse not over 10 inches in length, and bullheads and perch not over seven inches in length.
